Intermediate

Finished Size

18m (2y, 4y, 6y, 8y, 10y)

Chest: 22 (24, 26, 28, 30, 32)" [56 (61, 66, 71, 76, 81)cm]

Materials

Willow Yarns™ Fawn Worsted  4

(50% bamboo/50% acrylic; 50g/99yd)

- 731281-0003 Pattycake [3 (4, 5, 7, 8) balls]: MC
- 731281-0004 Powder Blue [1 (1, 1, 2, 2) balls]: CC1
- 731281-0012 Teddy Bear [all sizes 1 ball]: CC2

- US size 9 (5.5mm) 16" circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge
- US size 9 (5.5mm) 24" circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge
- US size 9 (5.5mm) dpn or size needed to obtain gauge
- Stitch markers
- Waste yarn, to hold sleeve sts
- Yarn needle

Gauge

16 sts x 20 rows = 4" (10.2cm) in St st

Save time, check your gauge.

Pattern Notes

- **Yoke Stripe Sequence:** 1 rnd CC1, 1 rnd CC2, 1 rnd CC1, 2 rnds MC, 2 rnds CC1, 2 rnds MC, 1 rnd CC1, 1 rnd CC2, 1 rnd CC1, 2 rnds MC, 2 rnds CC1, 2 rnds MC, 1 rnd CC1, 1 rnd CC2, 1 rnd CC1.
- **Edging Stripe Sequence:** 2 rnds MC, 1 rnd CC1, 1 rnd CC2, 1 rnd CC1, 2 rnds MC.
- CO using the 16" circular needle and switch to the 24" circular needle once you have enough sts. For the smallest sizes, you may need to use the 16" circular needle for the body after the sleeve sts are placed on holders.



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Instructions

Yoke

With 16" circular needle and MC, CO 1 st, pm, CO 1 st, pm, CO 4 sts, pm, CO 1 st, pm, CO 14 (16, 18, 18, 20, 22) sts, pm, CO 1 st, pm, CO 4 sts, pm, CO 1 st, pm, CO 1 st—28 (30, 32, 32, 34, 36) sts.

Row 1 (WS): P.

Row 2: CO 1 st, *k to m, M1, sl m, k1, sl m, M1; rep from * 3 more times, k to end.

Row 3: CO 1 st, p to end.

Row 4: CO 1 (2, 2, 2, 1, 2) sts, *k to m, M1, sl m, k1, sl m, M1; rep from * 3 more times, k to end.

Row 5: CO 1 (2, 2, 2, 1, 2) sts, p to end.

Row 6: CO 2 (2, 3, 2, 2, 2) sts, *k to m, M1, sl m, k1, sl m, M1; rep from * 3 more times, k to end.

Row 7: CO 2 (2, 3, 2, 2, 2) sts, p to end.

Row 8: *K to m, M1, sl m, k1, sl m, M1; rep from * 3 more times, k to end, CO 4 (4, 4, 6, 10, 10) sts—72 (76, 80, 80, 84, 88) sts.

Join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist work, work to first marker, this is now the beg of the rnd. Beg working in Yoke Stripe Sequence, once you've reached the end of the stripe sequence cont pat in MC.

K 1 rnd.

Inc Rnd: *Sl m, k1, sl m, M1, k to m, M1; rep from * 3 more times.

Rep Inc Rnd every 2 rnds 5 (6, 7, 9, 10, 11) more times. Rep Inc Rnd every 4 rnds 2 more times—136 (148, 160, 176, 188, 200) sts.

Divide for Sleeves

Removing raglan shaping markers as you go, sl next 36 (38, 40, 44, 46, 48) sts onto waste yarn, CO 3 sts, pm for new beg of rnd, CO 3 sts, k to m, sl next 36 (38, 40, 44, 46, 48) sts onto waste yarn, CO 6 sts, k to end of rnd—88 (96, 104, 112, 120, 128) sts.

Body

Work in St st until body measures 6 (7, 8, 9, 10½, 11)" [15.2 (17.8, 20.3, 22.9, 27, 28)cm] from underarm.

Edging

Beg working in Edging Stripe Sequence.

Next Rnd: *K2, p2; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rep above rnd 6 more times.

With MC, BO all sts in pat.

Sleeves

Place held sleeve sts onto dpns. Pick up and k 3 sts from underarm, pm for beg of rnd, pick up and k 3 more sts from underarm, k to end of rnd.

K 2 rnds.

Dec Rnd: K1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, ssk, k1—2 sts dec'd.

Rep Dec Rnd every sixth rnd 7 (7, 7, 8, 8, 8) more times—20 (22, 24, 26, 28, 30) sts rem.

K even until sleeve measures 9 (9½, 10, 10½, 12, 13¼)" [22.9 (24.1, 25, 27, 30, 34)cm] from underarm.

Edging

Beg working in Edging Stripe Sequence.

Next Rnd: *K2, p2; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rep above rnd 6 more times.

With MC, BO all sts in pat.

Neck Finishing

With MC and 16" circular needle, starting at the center back, pick up and k52 (56, 60, 60, 64, 68) sts along neck edge.

Next Rnd: *K2, p2; rep from * to end of rnd.

Cont in ribbing, work 3 more rnds in MC, work 1 rnd in CC1.

With CC2, BO all sts in pat. Weave in all ends and block.
