Instructions

Back

With smaller needles, CO 50 (54, 58, 62, 70, 74) sts.

Row 1 (WS): P2, *k2, p2; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: K2, *p2, k2; rep from * to end of row. Cont in ribbing until back measures 1½" (3.8cm). Switch to larger needles and work even in St st until back measures 10¼ (11, 12½, 14, 16½, 18)" [26 (28, 32, 36, 42, 46)cm].

Next Row: K14 (16, 18, 20, 24, 26), BO center 22 sts, k to end.

Left Shoulder

Work even on rem 14 (16, 18, 20, 24, 26) sts until back measures 10¾ (11½, 13, 14½, 17, 18½)" [27 (29, 33, 37, 43, 47)cm]. BO all sts.

Right Shoulder

Attach yarn at neck edge and work as for left shoulder.

Right Front

With smaller needles CO 30 (32, 34, 36, 40, 42) sts.

Row 1 (WS): P3 (1, 3, 1, 1, 3), [k2, p2] 4 (5, 5, 6, 7, 7) times, k1, p2, k2, p2, [k1, p1] 2 times.

Row 2: [K1, p1] 2 times, k2, p2, k2, p1, [k2, p2] 4 (5, 5, 6, 7, 7) times, k3 (1, 3, 1, 1, 3). Cont in ribbing as established until front measures 1½" (3.8cm), ending with a WS row.

Begin Cable

Row 1 (RS): With larger needles, [k1, p1] 2 times, work Right Twist Cable over next 6 sts, p1, pm, k to end of row.

Row 2: P to m, k1, work Right Twist Cable over next 6 sts, [k1, p1] 2 times.

Cont as established for 6 more rows.

Pocket

Row 1: Work to m, k1, pm, k13 (15, 17, 19, 21, 23), p1, k1, pm, turn.

You will now be working only on the 15 (17, 19, 21, 23, 25) sts bet the markers.

Row 2: P1, k1, p to m.

Dec Row: K to 4 before m, k2tog, p1, k1—1 st dec. Rep Dec Row every fourth row 5 more times—9 (11, 13, 15, 17, 19) sts rem.

Work even until pocket measures 4" (10.2cm), ending with a WS row.

Materials

- Willow Yarns™ Fawn Worsted 4
(50% bamboo/50% acrylic; 50g/99yds)
-731281-0004 Powder Blue [4 (5, 6, 7, 9, 10) balls]
- US size 8 (5mm) straight needles or size needed to obtain gauge
- US size 6 (4mm) straight needles
- Stitch holders
- Stitch markers
- Yarn needle
- Cable needle
- 7¾ (8½, 10, 11½, 14, 15½)" [20, (22, 25, 29, 36, 39)cm] separating zipper

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Gauge

18 sts x 28 rows = 4" (10.2cm) in St st using larger needle

Save time, check your gauge.

Stitch Guide

Right Twist Cable

(multiple of 6 sts)

Row 1 (RS): K6.

Row 2 and all WS rows: P6.

Row 3: Sl 3 sts onto cn and hold in back, k3, k3 from cn.

Rows 5, 7, 9, 11, 13: K6

Row 15: Rep Row 3.

Row 17: K6.

Rep Rows 1-18 for pat.

Left Twist Cable

(multiple of 6 sts)

Row 1 (RS): K6.

Row 2 and all WS rows: P6.

Row 3: Sl 3 sts onto cn and hold in front, k3, k3 from cn.

Rows 5, 7, 9, 11, 13: K6

Row 15: Rep Row 3.

Row 17: K6.

Rep Rows 1-18 for pat.

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Cut yarn, place sts on holder. Remove pocket markers.

Continue Front

Attach yarn at bottom right corner of pocket, pick up 1 st in the back of every pocket st across the row, k to end—30 (32, 34, 36, 40, 42) sts. Work even for 4" (10.2cm), ending with a WS row.

Join Pocket

Place pocket sts onto a spare needle, work to m, k1, hold pocket sts along front sts, k9 (11, 13, 15, 17, 19) knitting each st through 1 pocket st and 1 front st joining them tog, k to end of row. Work even until front measures 7¾ (8½, 10, 11½, 14, 15½)" [20 (22, 25, 29, 36, 39)cm], ending with a WS row.

Neck

Place 13 sts onto holder for hood, k to end of row. P 1 row.

Dec Row: K1, k2tog, k to end of row—1 st dec'd. Rep Dec Row every 2 rows 2 more times—14 (16, 18, 20, 24, 26) sts rem.

Work even until front measures 10¾ (11½, 13, 14½, 17, 18½)" [27 (29, 33, 37, 43, 47)cm]. BO all sts.

Left Front

With smaller needles CO 30 (32, 34, 36, 40, 42) sts.

Row 1 (WS): [P1, k1] 2 times, p2, k2, p2, k1, [p2, k2] 4 (5, 5, 6, 7, 7) times, p3 (1, 3, 1, 1, 3).

Row 2: K3 (1, 3, 1, 1, 3), [p2, k2] 4 (5, 5, 6, 7, 7) times, p1, k2, p2, k2, [p1, k1] 2 times.

Cont in ribbing as established until front measures 1½" (3.8cm), ending with a WS row.

Begin Cable

Row 1 (RS): With larger needles, k19 (21, 23, 25, 29, 31), pm, p1, work Left Twist Cable over next 6 sts, [p1, k1] 2 times.

Row 2: [P1, k1] 2 times, work Left Twist Cable over next 6 sts, k1, p to end.

Cont as established for 6 more rows.

Pocket

Row 1: K3 (3, 3, 3, 5, 5), pm, k1, p1, k13 (15, 17, 19, 21, 23), pm, turn.

You will now be working only on the 15 (17, 19, 21, 23, 25) sts bet the markers.

Row 2: P to 2 before m, k1, p1.

Dec Row: K1, p1, ssk, k to m—1 st dec.

Rep Dec Row every fourth row 5 more times—9 (11, 13, 15, 17, 19) sts rem.

Work even until pocket measures 4" (10.2cm), ending with a WS row.

Cut yarn, place sts on holder. Remove pocket markers.

Continue Front

Attach yarn at bottom right corner of pocket, pick up 1 st in the back of every pocket st across the row, work to end—30 (32, 34, 36, 40, 42) sts. Work even for 4" (10.2cm), ending with a WS row.

Join Pocket

Place pocket sts onto a spare needle, k3 (3, 3, 3, 5, 5), hold pocket sts along front sts, k9 (11, 13, 15, 17, 19) knitting each st through 1 pocket st and 1 front st joining them tog, work to end of row.

Work even until front measures 7¾ (8½, 10, 11½, 14, 15½)" [20 (22, 25, 29, 36, 39)cm], ending with a RS row.

Neck

Place 13 sts onto holder for hood, p to end of row.

Dec Row: K to last 3 sts, ssk, k1—1 st dec'd. Rep Dec Row every 2 rows 2 more times—14 (16, 18, 20, 24, 26) sts rem.

Work even until front measures 10¾ (11½, 13, 14½, 17, 18½)" [27 (29, 33, 37, 43, 47)cm]. BO all sts.

Sleeves

With smaller needles, CO 22 (26, 34, 38, 42, 46) sts.

Row 1 (WS): P2, *k2, p2; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: K2, *p2, k2; rep from * to end of row. Cont in ribbing until sleeve measures 1½" (3.8cm).

Switch to larger needles and work 2 rows in St st.

Inc Row: K1, M1, k to last st, M1, k1.

Rep Inc Row every 2 (4, 4, 4, 4) rows 12 (12, 13, 14, 15, 16) times—46 (50, 60, 66, 72, 78) sts.

Work even until sleeve measures 8½ (12, 13, 13½, 14½, 15¾)" [22 (30, 33, 34, 37, 40)cm]. BO all sts.

Hood

Sew shoulder seams. With larger needle, work across 14 sts from holder, pick up and k 17 sts along right front neck, 22 sts along



back of neck, 17 sts along left front neck, and work across 14 sts from holder—82 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Work to m cont ribbing and cable from left front, p to m, work to end cont ribbing and cable from right front.

Inc Row: Work to m, sl m, M1, k to m, M1, sl m, work to end—2 sts inc'd.

Rep Inc Row every 4 rows 1 (3, 3, 5, 5, 7) more times—86 (90, 90, 94, 94, 98) sts.

Work even until hood measures 9 (9½, 10, 10½, 11, 11½)" [23 (24, 25, 27, 28, 29)cm].

Work across 43 (45, 45, 47, 47, 49) sts, fold hood in half with WS tog. Using Kitchener st graft top of hood closed.

Finishing

Sew sleeves onto body, centering sleeves on the shoulder seams. Seam sleeves and side seams. Weave in all ends. Block. Sew in the zipper. The top of the zipper should line up with the point where the cable sts were placed on a st holder.

PROJECT TIP

For a zipper that stays lying flat, wash the zipper and sweater using the method recommended by the ball band on the yarn before sewing in the zipper.
