

wrapped wreath with crochet flowers

12" (30.5cm) diameter

Materials



- Willow Yarns™ Daily Worsted (100% superwash wool; 100g/218yds)
-732247-0040 Campfire (1 ball): A
-732247-0003 Brick (1 ball): B
-732247-0017 Blue Sky (1 ball): C
-732247-0022 Blossom (1 ball): D
- US size H-8 (5mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- 12" (30.5cm) Styrofoam wreath form
- Glue
- Yarn needle

Stitch Guide

Rosette [Small (Medium, Large)]

Ch 13 (17, 27).

Row 1: Dc in fifth ch from hook (V-st made), *ch 1, sk 1 ch, [dc, ch 1, dc] V-st made; rep from * across.

Row 2: Ch 3, 5 dc in first ch-sp, *sc in next ch-sp, 6 dc in next ch-sp (shell made); rep from *, ending 6 dc in last ch-1 sp. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for anchoring rosette.

Finishing Rosette: Thread needle with tail and weave to base of last st. Roll the first shell tightly to form center of rosette. Anchor at base of shell with 2 small sts. Roll rem rosette strip to form flower shape. Secure by stitching in and out through layers of foundation ch at bottom of rosette.



Instructions

With A, secure end to wreath form with small dab of glue. With ball of yarn in hand, wrap yarn evenly and carefully around form. Secure yarn to wreath every few wraps with small dab of glue. Cont until entire wreath is covered in yarn. Trim yarn and glue end to wreath.

Rosettes

With B, make 2 Large rosettes.

With C, make 2 Small rosettes.

With D, make 1 Medium rosette.

Tie or glue rosettes to bottom of wreath in a cluster.
