

triad baskets

Skill Level

Easy

Finished Sizes

Small:

6" x 5" (15.2cm x 12.7cm)

Medium:

7" x 6" (17.8cm x 15.2cm)

Large:

9" x 8" (22.9cm x 20.3cm)

Materials



- Willow Yarns™ Burrow Worsted (75% acrylic/25% washable wool; 100g/197yds)
 - 730001-0008 Peach (1 ball) for Small basket
 - 730001-0051 Mossy (2 balls) for Medium basket
 - 730001-0007 Curry (2 balls) for Large basket
- US size J-10 (6mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle

Gauge

10 dc x 7 rows = 4" (10.2cm)

Save time, check your gauge.

Pattern Note

- Baskets are made holding two strands of yarn together.

Instructions

Small Basket

With Peach yarn, ch 4; join with sl st to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 2 (counts as first dc here and throughout), work 11 hdc in ring; join with a sl st in top of ch-2—2 hdc.

Rnd 2: Working in back lps only, ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, (2 hdc in next hdc) 11 times; join with sl st—24 hdc.

Note: Cont working in back lps unless otherwise stated.

Rnd 3: Ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, hdc in next st, (2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st) 11 times; join with sl st—36 hdc.

Rnd 4: Ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, hdc in next 2 hdc, (2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts) 11 times; join with sl st—48 hdc.

Rnds 5-13: Hdc in each st around.

Rnd 14: Working in both lps, sc in next 46 sts, sl st in last 2 sts. Fasten off and weave in all ends.



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Medium Basket

With Mossy yarn, ch 4; join with sl st to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 2 (counts as first dc here and throughout), work 11 hdc in ring; join with a sl st in top of ch-2— 2 hdc.

Rnd 2: Working in back lps only, ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, (2 hdc in next hdc) 11 times; join with sl st—24 hdc.

Note: Cont working in back lps unless otherwise stated.

Rnd 3: Ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, hdc in next st, (2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st) 11 times; join with sl st—36 hdc.

Rnd 4: Ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, hdc in next 2 hdc, (2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts) 11 times; join with sl st—48 hdc.

Rnd 5: Ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, hdc in next 3 hdc, (2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 3 sts) 11 times; join with sl st—60 hdc.

Rnds 6-16: Hdc in each st around.

Rnd 17: Working in both lps, sc in next 58 sts, sl st in last 2 sts. Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Large Basket

With Curry yarn, ch 4; join with sl st to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 2 (counts as first dc here and throughout), work 11 hdc in ring; join with a sl st in top of ch-2—12 hdc.

Rnd 2: Working in back lps only, ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, (2 hdc in next hdc) 11 times; join with sl st—24 hdc.

Note: Cont working in back lps unless otherwise stated.

Rnd 3: Ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, hdc in next st, (2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st) 11 times; join with sl st—36 hdc.

Rnd 4: Ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, hdc in next 2 hdc, (2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts) 11 times; join with sl st—48 hdc.

Rnd 5: Ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, hdc in next 3 hdc, (2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 3 sts) 11 times; join with sl st—60 hdc.

Rnd 6: Ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, hdc in next 4 hdc, (2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 4 sts) 11 times; join with sl st—72 hdc.

Rnds 7-21: Hdc in each st around.

Rnd 22: Working in both lps, sc in next 70 sts, sl st in last 2 sts. Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Optional

If desired, you may line containers with felt or use a bowl designed for food products.

PROJECT TIP

Organize Your Supplies

Knitting and crocheting is easier and more enjoyable when your supplies are accessible and organized.

Try keeping a notebook of information on the yarn in your stash, including brand, color name or number, weight, care instructions, and amount that you have left. Update the list regularly so you always know what you have on hand. Also, keep your needles and hooks organized by size so they are easy to access for each project.
