

flower bud hat


Skill Level

Intermediate

Finished Size

Circumference: 21" (53cm)

Materials

- Willow Yarns™ Vines  (100% superwash merino; 50g/44yd)
-731090-0005 Morning Glories (2 balls)
- US size 11 (8mm) 16" circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge
- US size 11 (8mm) dpn
- Stitch markers
- Yarn needle

Gauge

12 sts x 18 rnds = 4" (10.2cm) in rev St st

Save time, check your gauge.

Stitch Guide

Lace Panel:

(multiple of 5 sts)

Rnd 1: Yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo.

Rnds 2 and 4: K.

Rnd 3: K1, yo, sl 1, k2tog, pssso, yo, k1.

Rep Rnds 1-4 for pat.

Pattern Note

Hat can be made taller by working additional rnds in the crown section. Be sure to add rnds in multiples of 4.



Instructions

CO 60 sts. Pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist work.

Brim

Rnds 1-4: *K1 tbl, p1; rep from * around.

Crown

Rnd 1: Work Row 1 of Lace Panel over 5 sts, p to end.

Work even for 15 more rnds, ending with Rnd 4 of Lace Panel.

Shape Crown

Rnd 1: Work in pat for 5 sts, (p2tog, p3) 11 times—49 sts.

Rnds 2-3: Work even.

Rnd 4: Work in pat for 5 sts, (p2tog, p2) 11 times—38 sts.

Rnds 5-6: Work even.

Rnd 7: Work in pat for 5 sts, (p2tog, p1) 11 times—27 sts.

Rnd 8: Work even.

Rnd 9: Ssk, k1, k2tog, (p2tog) 11 times—14 sts.

Rnd 10: Sl 1, k2tog, pssso, (p2tog) 5 times, p1—7 sts.

Cut yarn, thread on darning needle, and run through rem sts twice. Pull snug.

Finishing

Weave in ends. Block to open up lace.
