

# sparkling champagne gift bag

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## Skill Level


Intermediate

## Finished Size

Circumference: 14" (36cm)

Height: 13" (33cm)

## Materials

- Willow Yarns™ Firefly  (52% metallic/48% polyester; 50g/190yd -731288-0001 Milky Way (2 balls)
- US size G-6 (4mm) hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Stitch markers
- Yarn needle

## Gauge

Rnds 1-3 = 4" (10.2cm) across

Save time, check your gauge.

## Pattern Note

- Bag is worked from the bottom up.

## Instructions

Ch 6, sl st to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), (3 dc in ring, ch 1) 5 times, 2 dc in ring, sl st in third ch of beg ch 4 to join—6 ch-1 sps.

**Rnd 2:** Sl st in next ch-1 sp, ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2 throughout), (3 dc, ch 1) in same sp, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 1) in each ch-1 sp around, 2 dc in first ch-1 sp, sl st in third ch of beg ch 5 to join—6 ch-2 sps.

**Rnd 3:** Sl st in next ch-2 sp, ch 5, (3 dc, ch 2) in same sp, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 2) in each ch-2 sp around, 2 dc in first ch-2 sp, sl st in third ch of beg ch 5 to join—12 ch-2 sps.

**Rnd 4:** Sl st in next ch-2 sp, ch 5, 3 dc in same sp, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in each ch-2 sp around, 2 dc in first ch-2 sp, sl st in third ch of beg ch 5 to join—12 ch-2 sps.

**Rnd 5:** Sl st in next ch-2 sp, ch 5, (3 dc, ch 1) in same sp, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 1) in each ch-2 sp around, 2 dc in first ch-2 sp, sl st in third ch of beg ch 5 to join—12 ch-2 sps.

Rep Rnd 5 for 12" (30cm).

**Last Rnd:** Sl st in next ch-2 sp, ch 3, 9 dc in same sp, 10 dc in each ch-2 sp around, sl st in third ch of beg ch 3 to join. Fasten off.

## Finishing

**Drawstring:** Ch 18" (46cm). Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Thread drawstring through bag approx 5" (12.7cm) from top edge.



## PROJECT TIP

### Organize Your Supplies

*Knitting and crocheting is easier and more enjoyable when your supplies are accessible and organized. Try keeping a notebook of information on the yarn in your stash, including brand, color name or number, weight, care instructions, and amount that you have left. Update the list regularly so you always know what you have on hand. Also, keep your needles and hooks organized by size so they are easy to access for each project.*
