Finished Size

12mos (2yrs, 4yrs, 6yrs, 8yrs)

Chest: 20 (24, 26, 28, 30)" [51 (61, 66, 71, 76)cm]

Length: 11 (12, 14, 16, 18)" [28 (30, 36, 41, 46)cm]

Materials

- Willow Yarns™ Field 4
(53% cotton/47% linen; 100g/176yd)
-732088-0010 Zephyr [1 (1, 1, 2, 2) balls]: A
-732088-0008 Sea Grass [1 (1, 1, 1, 2) balls]: B
- US size 8 (5mm) straight or circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge
- US size 7 (4.5mm) straight or circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge
- US size 7 (4.5mm) dpn or size needed to obtain gauge
- Stitch markers
- Yarn needle
- 9 (9, 11, 11, 13) 5/8" (1.6cm) buttons
- 9 (9, 11, 11, 13) 1/2" (1.3cm) sew-on snaps
- Sewing needle and thread
- Waste yarn

Gauge

20 sts x 32 rows = 4" (10.2cm) in waffle st using size 8 needle

20 sts x 24 rows = 4" (10.2cm) in St st using size 7 needle

Save time, check your gauge.

Stitch Guide

waffle st:

(multiple of 2 sts + 1)

Row 1 (RS): K.

Row 2: *K1, sl 1 wyif; rep from * to last st, k1.

Rep Rows 1-2 for pat.

Stripe Sequence:

*2 rows B, 2 rows A; rep from * to end.

Pattern Notes

- Cardigan is worked in 2-row stripes throughout with garter st borders at the neck, hem, and cuffs in A. Loosely carry the unused color up the edge of the work.
- Cardigan is worked top down.
- When working waffle st in the yoke, add new sts from inc's into the pat when possible, keeping extra sts in St st until they are able to be added in.



Instructions

Neck Edging

With A and size 7 needles, CO 105 (109, 107, 125, 123) sts.

Row 1 (WS): Sl 1 wyif, k to end.

Row 2: Sl 1 wyif, k2, pm, k24 (24, 23, 29, 29) for sleeve, pm, k27 (29, 29, 32, 31) for back, pm, k24 (24, 23, 29, 29) for sleeve, pm, k24 (26, 26, 29, 28) for front, pm, k3.

Row 3: Sl 1 wyif, k to end.

Row 4: Sl 1 wyif, k to second m, sl m, kfb, k to 1 st before next m, kfb, sl m, k to next m, sl m, kfb, k to 1 st before next m, kfb, sl m, k3—4 sts inc'd.

Row 5: Sl 1 wyif, k to end.

Yoke

Row 1 (inc body and sleeves): With B and size 8 needles, sl 1 wyif, k2, sl m, *kfb, work waffle st to 1 st before m, kfb, sl m; rep from * 3 more times, k3—8 sts inc'd.

Row 2: With B, sl 1 wyif, k2, *sl m, p1, work in waffle st to 2 sts before m, p2; rep from * 3 more times, sl m, k3.

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Row 3 (inc body only): With A, sl 1 wyif, k2, *sl m, k2, work in waffle st to 1 st before m, k1, sl m, kfb, work in waffle st to 1 st before m, kfb; rep from * once more, sl m, k3—4 sts inc'd.

Row 4: With A, sl 1 wyif, k2, *sl m, p1, work in waffle st to 2 sts before m, p2; rep from * 3 more times, sl m, k3.

Rep Rows 1-4 three (four, five, four, four) more times. Cont in Stripe Sequence, rep Rows 3-4 until there are 45 (55, 59, 64, 69) sts in the back section of the sweater (bet second and third m)—161 (185, 195, 213, 223) sts total.

Divide for Sleeves

Cont to work in Stripe Sequence to bottom border.

Row 1 (RS): With size 7 needles and removing all m as you go, sl 1 wyif, k2,

*sl next 33 (35, 36, 40, 40) sts onto waste yarn for sleeve, CO 4 (4, 5, 5, 5) sts, k to next m; rep from * once more, k to end—103 (123, 133, 143, 153) sts.

Row 2: Sl 1 wyif, k2, p to last 3 sts, k3.

Body

Row 1 (RS): Sl 1 wyif, k across.

Row 2: Sl 1 wyif, k2, p to last 3 sts, k3.

Rep last 2 rows until cardigan measures 9½ (10½, 12½, 14½, 16½)" [24.1 (27, 32, 37, 42)cm] from top of shoulder (center of CO sleeve sts), ending with a WS row.

Bottom Border

With A, k 10 rows, slipping the first st of each row wyif. BO all sts.

Sleeve Cuffs

Rnd 1: Place sleeve sts from waste yarn onto dpn. With A, pick up and k5 (5, 6, 6, 6) sts from underarm, k to end of rnd, pm for beg of rnd.

Rnd 2: P.

Rnd 3: K.

Rnd 4: P.

Rep Rnds 3-4 three more times.

BO all sts loosely.

Finishing

Weave in ends. Sew 9 (9, 11, 11, 13) snaps evenly spaced along RS of left button band. Sew opposite side of snaps along WS of right button band. Sew buttons on RS of right button band, matching position of snaps.
