

crazy daisy key ring collection



Skill Level
Intermediate

- 5" (12.7cm) zipper
- Sewing needle and thread

Finished Size
Key Cover: 1¼" (3.2cm) across to fit most standard house keys
Coin Purse: 3¼" x 4¾" (8.3cm x 12.1cm)

Gauge
Key Cover: Rnds 1-4 = 1¼" (3.2cm) across with size C-2 hook
Coin Purse: 22 sc x 26 rnds = 4" (10.2cm) with size E-4 hook
Save time, check your gauge.

Rnd 4: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc) twice, 4 sc in ch-3 sp, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc) 3 times, sl st in next sc—24 sc. Fasten off.

Materials

- Willow Yarns™ Guppie ³ (100% micro acrylic; 100g/284yd)
 - 736372-0002 Urchin (1 ball): A
 - 736372-0003 Kelp (1 ball): B
 - 736372-0004 Seawater (1 ball): C
 - 736372-0005 Precious Stones (1 ball): D
- US size C-2 (2.75mm) hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- US size E-4 (3.5mm) hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Stitch markers
- Yarn needle

Stitch Guide

Key Cover Front:

With size C-2 hook, ch 2.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in second ch from hook. Mark last sc with removable m for last st of rnd. Working in a spiral, move m each rnd to mark the last st.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around—12 sc.

Rnd 3: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) twice, ch 3, sk 2 sc, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) 3 times—15 sc.

Key Cover Back:

Work as for Key Cover Front through Rnd 4, end with sl st in next 2 sc, do not fasten off.

Align back and front with WS tog, matching opening for key ring. With key in place bet the front and back, sc around, leaving opening for long end of key.

Instructions

Daisy Key Cover

With B, work Key Cover Front.

Flower Center

With A and size C-2 hook, ch 4.

Rnd 1: 11 dc in fourth ch from hook, sl st in top of beg ch 3 to join.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, (sk 1 dc, sc in next dc) around, sl st in first sc to join. Fasten off.

Petals

With D and size C-2 hook, ch 6. *Sc in second ch from hook, hdc in next 3 ch, sc in next ch,** ch 6; rep from * 4 more times. Rep from * to ** once more to form 6 petals, sl st in first ch of first petal to join in a ring. Fasten off.

Finishing

Sew ring of petals centered on front of cover. Flatten flower center and sew over center of petals. With D, work Key Cover Back and seam closed.

Pansy Key Cover

With A, work Key Cover Front.

Petals

With D and size C-2 hook, ch 9.

Row 1: (3 dc, sc) in third ch from hook, (ch 1, 3 dc, sc) in each ch across. Fasten off—7 petals.

Finishing

Allow petals to twist into a pansy shape, sew to front of cover with doubled petals on the bottom. Work several French knots with C in the center. With A, work Key Cover Back and seam closed.

PROJECT TIP

Organize Your Supplies

Knitting and crocheting is easier and more enjoyable when your supplies are accessible and organized. Try keeping a notebook of information on the yarn in your stash, including brand, color name or number, weight, care instructions, and amount that you have left. Update the list regularly so you always know what you have on hand. Also, keep your needles and hooks organized by size so they are easy to access for each project.

Clover Key Cover

With D, work Key Cover Front.

Petals

With C and size C-2 hook, ch 6, sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: *Ch 4, yo twice, insert hook in ring and draw up a lp, (yo and draw through 2 lps) twice, yo, insert hook in ring and draw up a lp, (yo and draw through 2 lps) 3 times, ch 4, sl st in ring; rep from * 3 more times, sl st in first ch to join. Fasten off.

Finishing

Sew petals to front of cover. With D, work Key Cover Back and seam closed.

Coin Purse

With C and size E-4 hook, ch 50.

Sc in first ch, joining beg ch in ring without twisting, sc in next 49 ch. Mark last sc with removable m for last st of rnd. Working in a spiral, move m each rnd to mark the last st.

With C, sc 14 rnds. Cut C, change to B.

With B, sc 3 rnds.

Flatten coin purse, sc across, seaming bottom closed.

Tab

With C and size E-4 hook, ch 5.

Row 1: Sc in second ch from hook, sc across, turn—4 sc.

Rows 2-6: Ch 1, sc across, turn. Fasten off.

Finishing

With A, B, and D, embroider flowers, stems, and leaves using lazy daisy sts, backstitch, and French knots. Sew zipper into top opening, trimming if necessary. Fold Tab in half and sew to upper corner. Weave in ends.
