Top Edge: 28" (71cm)

Bottom Edge: 64" (163cm)

Materials

- Willow Yarns™ Dappled ¹ (65% superwash wool/27% nylon/8% polyester; 50g/218yd)
-730957-0012 Electric (4 balls): A
-730957-0001 Fractal (2 ball): B
- US size G-6 (4mm) hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle

Gauge

Star = 4" (10.2cm) across, point to point and 3½" (9cm) tall, blocked

Supernova = 12" (30cm) across, point to point, blocked

Save time, check your gauge.

Stitch Guide

Star:

With A, ch 4, sl st to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 6 sc in ring, sl st in first sc to join.

Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in same sc, (ch 3, 2 dc in next sc) 5 times, ch 3, sl st in third ch of beg ch 3 to join—6 ch-3 sps.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, 5 sc in each ch-3 sp around, sl st in first sc to join—30 sc.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc bet first and last sc of Rnd 3, *ch 2, sk 2 sc, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next sc, ch 2, sk 2 sc, **sc bet skipped and next sc; rep from * around, ending last rep at **, sl st in first sc to join—6 points formed. Fasten off.

Joining Stars: After the first Star is completed, join Stars on Rnd 4 by working (ch 1, sl st in adjoining ch-3 sp, ch 1) in place of the ch 3 on points to be joined.

Supernova:

With A, ch 8, sl st to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 12 sc in ring, sl st in first sc to join.

Rnd 2: Ch 11 (counts as tr, ch 7), (sk next sc, tr in next sc, ch 7) 5 times, sl st in fourth ch of beg ch 11 to join—6 ch-7 sps.

Rnd 3: Sl st in next sp, ch 1, (sc, hdc, 2 dc, tr, dtr, tr, 2 dc, hdc, sc) in each ch-7 sp around, sl st in first sc to join. Fasten off.

Rnd 4: Join B bet any 2 sc, ch 9 (counts as tr, ch 5), tr in same sp, ch 11, *(tr, ch 5 tr) bet next 2 sc, ch 11; rep from * around, sl st in fourth ch of beg ch 9 to join—6 ch-11 sps.

Rnd 5: Sl st to center of ch-5 sp, ch 4 (counts as tr throughout), (2 tr, ch 5, 3 tr) in same ch-5 sp, *ch 6, (sc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, sc) in ch-11 sp, ch 6, **

(3 tr, ch 5, 3 tr) in ch-5 sp; rep from * around, ending last rep at **, sl st in fourth ch of beg ch 4 to join.

Rnd 6: Ch 4, tr in next 2 tr, (4 tr, ch 3, 4 tr) in ch-5 sp, tr in next 3 tr, *ch 4, tr in next 2 ch-6 sps, ch 4, **tr in next 3 tr, (4 tr, ch 3, 4 tr) in ch-5 sp, tr in next 3 tr; rep from * around, ending last rep at **, sl st in fourth ch of beg ch 4 to join.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, *sc in next 7 tr, (sc, ch 3, sc) in ch-3 sp, sc in next 7 tr, ch 3, 3 sc in ch-4 sp, 3 sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 3; rep from * around, sl st in first sc to join. Fasten off.



Pattern Notes

- Shawlette can easily be made larger by continuing to add rows of Stars to the long edge of the shawlette. Each additional row will take 3 more Stars, 1 more in each section. Each ball of Dappled makes approx 30 Stars.
- Supernova motifs will look best if you start with a section of color A that highly contrasts with color B.

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PROJECT TIP

Organize Your Supplies

Knitting and crocheting is easier and more enjoyable when your supplies are accessible and organized. Try keeping a notebook of information on the yarn in your stash, including brand, color name or number, weight, care instructions, and amount that you have left. Update the list regularly so you always know what you have on hand. Also, keep your needles and hooks organized by size so they are easy to access for each project.

Instructions

Make 3 Supernova motifs.
Make 3 Stars, joining according to the center pink row on the Assembly Diagram.
Make 60 more Stars, joining them as you go and working out from the center according to the Assembly Diagram, joining in Supernova motifs when you reach the center of each section.

Finishing

Weave in ends. Gently block shawl to open up Stars, pinning points if necessary.
