## Skill Level

Intermediate

## Finished Size

21" x 98" (53cm x 249cm)

## Materials

- Willow Yarns™ Stream   
(70% superwash wool/30% silk;  
50g/437yd)  
-732250-0026 Pomegranate  
(4 balls)
- US size C-2 (2.75mm) hook or size  
needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle

## Gauge

2 pat reps = 3" x 5" (7.6cm x 12.7cm)  
tall, blocked

*Save time, check your gauge.*

## Stitch Guide

**4dc-cl:** (Yo, insert hook in indicated  
sp or ch, yo and pull up a lp, yo and  
draw through 2 lps on hook) 4 times  
in indicated sp or ch, yo and draw  
through all lps on hook.



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## Instructions

## Center

Ch 102.

**Row 1 (RS):** Sc in second ch from hook, \*sc in next ch, ch 3, sk 3 ch, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch, ch 3, sk 3 ch, sc in next 2 ch; rep from \* 9 more times, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*ch 4, 5 dc in ch-2 sp, ch 4, sk next sc, sc in next sc; rep from \* across, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 7 (counts as tr, ch 3), \*sc in each of next 5 dc, \*\*ch 5; rep from \* across, ending at \*\*, ch 3, tr in next sc, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in tr, \*ch 3, sk 1 sc, sc in next 3 sc, ch 3, \*\*sk 2 ch, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch; rep from \* across, ending at \*\*, 2 dc in fourth ch of beg ch 7, turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in first dc, \*ch 4, sk 1 sc, sc in next sc, ch 4, \*\*5 dc in ch-2 sp; rep from \* across, ending at \*\*, 3 dc in third ch of beg ch 3, turn.

**Row 6:** Ch 1, sc in first 3 dc, \*ch 5, \*\*sc in each of next 5 dc; rep from \* across, ending at \*\*, sc in next 2 dc, sc in third ch of beg ch 3, turn.

**Row 7:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*sc in next sc, ch 3, sk 2 ch, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch, ch 3, sk 1 sc, sc in next 2 sc; rep from \* across, turn.

Rep Rows 2-7 thirty-nine more times. Fasten off.

## Border

Attach yarn at any corner.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, work 1,376 sc evenly around stole (approx 128 on each short side and 560 on each long edge—approx 14 sc per 6 row rep), sl st in first sc to join. **Note:** Sc must be a multiple of 16, but if you are 16

or even 32 sc over or under total it will still look fine, just know your numbers will be different at the end of each rnd.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, (sc in next sc, ch 3, sk 3 sc) around, sl st in first sc to join—344 ch-3 sps.

**Rnd 3:** Sl st in ch-3 sp, ch 1, (sc in ch-3 sp, ch 3) around, sl st in first sc to join—344 ch-3 sps.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1, (sc in sc, ch 6, sc in next sc, 3 sc in next ch-3 sp) around, sl st in first sc to join—172 ch-6 sps.

**Rnd 5:** Sl st to center of ch-6 sp, ch 1, \*sc in ch-6 sp, ch 4, (4dc-cl, ch 3, 4dc-cl, ch 3, 4dc-cl) in next ch-6 sp, ch 4; rep from \* around, sl st in first sc to join—258 4dc-cl.

**Rnd 6:** Ch 7 (counts as tr, ch 3), \*sk 3 ch, 4dc-cl in next ch, (ch 3, 4dc-cl in next ch-3 sp) twice, ch 3, 4dc-cl in first ch of ch-4 sp, ch 3, \*\*tr in sc, ch 3; rep from \* around ending at \*\*, sl st in fourth ch of beg ch 7 to join—344 4dc-cl, 86 tr.

**Rnd 7:** Sl st in ch-3 sp, ch 1, \*(sc in ch-3 sp, ch 3) twice, 4 dc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, (sc in ch-3 sp, ch 3) twice; rep from \* around, sl st in first sc to join.

**Rnd 8:** Sl st in ch-3 sp, ch 1, \*(sc in ch-3 sp, ch 3) twice, sk 1 dc, dc in next 2 dc, ch 3, (sc in ch-3 sp, ch 3) 3 times; rep from \* around, sl st in first sc to join.

**Rnd 9:** Sl st in ch-3 sp, ch 1, \*3 sc in each of next 2 ch-3 sps, sc in next dc, ch 3, sc in next dc, 3 sc in each of next 3 ch-3 sps; rep from \* around, sl st in first sc to join—86 ch-3 sps. Fasten off.

## Finishing

Weave in ends.

Block stole to final dimensions, pinning out each ch-3 sp to form a point.
