

# italiano chevron blanket



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## Skill Level


Easy

## Finished Size

Width: 24 (35)" [61 (89)cm]

Length: 30 (42)" [76 (107)cm]

## Materials

- Willow Yarns™ Attire Fingering  (100% superwash extra fine merino; 50g/143yd)
  - 732259-0001 Snow [2 (3) balls]: A
  - 732259-00016 Vivid [1 (2) balls]: B
  - 732259-0009 Wasabi [1 (2) balls]: C
  - 732259-0013 Accent [1 (2) balls]: D
  - 732259-0025 Breakwater [1 (2) balls]: E
  - 732259-0017 Lipstick [1 (2) balls]: F
- US size E-4 (3.5mm) hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle

## Gauge

24 sts x 11 rows = 4" (10.2cm) in chevron pat

*Save time, check your gauge.*

## Stitch Guide

### chevron pat:

(multiple of 12 + 3 ch)

**Row 1 (RS):** Dc in fourth ch from hook, \*dc in next 3 ch, (dc2tog over next 2 ch) twice, dc in next 3 ch, \*\*2 dc in each of next 2 ch; rep from \*, ending last rep at \*\*, 2 dc in last ch, turn.

**Row 2 (WS):** Ch 1, working in back lp only across, \*2 sc in next dc, sc in next 3 dc, (sc2tog over next 2 dc) twice, sc in next 3 dc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* across, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), working in back lp only across, dc in first sc, \*dc in next 3 sc, (dc2tog over next 2 sc) twice, dc in next 3 sc, \*\*2 dc in each of next 2 sc; rep from \*, ending last rep at \*\*, 2 dc in last sc, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, working in back lp only across, \*2 sc in next dc, sc in next 3 dc, (sc2tog over next 2 dc) twice, sc in next 3 dc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* across, turn.

Rep Rows 3-4 for pat.

## Instructions

With A, ch 147 (207).

Work Rows 1-2 of chevron pat.

Cont in chevron pat, working in stripe pat as follows: \*2 rows B, 2 rows C, 2 rows D, 2 rows E, 2 rows F, 2 rows A; rep from \* until blanket measures approx 30 (42)" [76 (107)cm], ending with 2 rows in A.

Turn and with A, work 1 rnd of dc evenly around blanket.

Fasten off.

## Finishing

Weave in ends. Lightly block.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**approx:** approximately

**ch:** chain

**cont:** continue

**dc:** double crochet

**dc2tog:** double crochet 2 stitches together

**lp:** loop

**pat:** pattern

**rep:** repeat/repeats

**rnd/rnds:** round/rounds

**RS:** right side

**sc:** single crochet

**sc2tog:** single crochet 2 stitches together

**st/sts:** stitch/stitches

**WS:** wrong side

## PROJECT TIP

### Organize Your Supplies

*Knitting and crocheting is easier and more enjoyable when your supplies are accessible and organized. Try keeping a notebook of information on the yarn in your stash, including brand, color name or number, weight, care instructions, and amount that you have left. Update the list regularly so you always know what you have on hand. Also, keep your needles and hooks organized by size so they are easy to access for each project.*
