

diagonal trivet set

Finished Size

Width: 5 (7, 9)" [12.7 (17.8, 22.9)cm]

Materials

- Willow Yarns™ Sudsy Spray 4
(85% cotton/15% polyester;
100g/175yd)
-732190-0006 Blue Jean
(1 ball all sizes): A
-732190-0001 Peacock Blue
(1 ball all sizes): B
- US size I-9 (5.5mm) hook or size
needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle

Gauge

14 sc x 13 rows = 4" (10.2cm) in sc in
back lp only

Save time, check your gauge.



ABBREVIATIONS

beg: begin/beginning

ch/chs: chain/chains

cm: centimeter

lp: loop

rep: repeat/repeats

rnd/rnds: round/rounds

sc: single crochet

sl st: slip stitch

tog: together

Instructions

With A, ch 25 (36, 45).

Rnd 1: Working in back lp of the ch across, 2 sc in second ch from hook, sc in next 23 (34, 43) chs, turn and work back across the beg ch in the unused lp, 2 sc in next next ch, sc in the next 23 (34, 43) ch, sl st in first sc to join—50 (72, 90) sc.

Rnd 2: With A, ch 1, work in the back lp only of every sc around, sl st in first sc to join.

Drop A and join B.

Rnds 3-4: With B, ch 1, sc in the back lp only of every sc around, sl st in first sc to join.

Rnds 5-6: With A, ch 1, sc in the back lp only of every sc around, sl st in first sc to join.

Rep Rnds 3-6 until piece measures 3½ (5, 6¼)" [8.9cm (12.7, 15.9)cm], ending with Rnd 4 or 6.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for seaming.

Finishing

With beg ch flat against the table, flatten piece so it forms a double thick square with the beg ch running diagonally on the bottom side and the last row comes tog to form the opposite diagonal on the top.

Weave in all ends except final tail.

Thread tail on yarn needle and sew closed final edge.

Weave in end.
