Length: 22" (56cm)

Materials

- Willow Yarns™ Daily Tweed  4
Worsted (90% superwash wool/
7% acrylic/3% viscose; 100g/218yd)
-731218-0013 Fossil [3 (4, 5) balls]
- US size 7 (4.5mm) straight needles
or size needed to obtain gauge
- Stitch markers
- Yarn needle
- Stitch holder
- Six 1" (2.5cm) buttons

Gauge

20 sts x 28 rows = 4" (10.2cm) in
double seed st

Save time, check your gauge.

Stitch Guide

double seed st:

(multiple of 2 sts + 1)

Row 1 (RS): K1, *p1, k1; rep from
* across.

Rows 2-3: P1, *k1, p1; rep from
* across.

Row 4: K1, *p1, k1; rep from * across.
Rep Rows 1-4 for pat.

diamonds:

(multiple of 10 sts + 1)

Row 1 (RS): K1, *p1, k3, p1, k3, p1,
k1; rep from * across.

Row 2 (WS): P1, *k1, p3, k1, p3, k1,
p1; rep from * across.

Row 3: P1, *k3, p1, k1, p1, k3, p1; rep
from * across.

Row 4: K1, *p3, k1, p1, k1, p3, k1;
rep from * across.

Row 5: P1, *k2, (p1, k1) twice, p1,
k2, p1; rep from * across.

Row 6: K1, *p2, (k1, p1) twice, k1,
p2, k1; rep from * across.

Rows 7-8: Rep Rows 3-4.

Rows 9-10: Rep Rows 1-2.

Row 11: P1, *k1, p1, k2, p1, k2, p1,
k1, p1; rep from * across.

Row 12: K1, *p1, k1, p2, k1, p2, k1,
p1, k1; rep from * across.

Rep Rows 1-12 for pat.

Instructions

Back

CO 103 (123, 143) sts.

Starting with Row 4 of pat, work in
double seed st for 6" (15.2cm), ending
with a WS row.

Next Row (RS): Work 11 sts in double
seed st, pm, work next 81 (91, 101) sts in
Row 1 of diamonds, pm, work 11 sts in
double seed st.

Next Row (WS): Work in double seed st
to m, sl m, work in diamonds to next m,
sl m, work in double seed st to end.

Cont as established until piece measures
18" (46cm), ending with a WS row.

Neck Trim

Work in double seed st to m, sl m, work
next 21 (31, 31) sts in diamonds, pm,
work next 39 (29, 39) sts in double seed
st, pm, work in diamonds to next m, sl m,
work in double seed st to end.
Cont as established for 2" (5.1cm), ending
with a WS row.

Left Front

Row 1 (RS): Work in pat as established
over 41 (47, 51) sts, BO next 21 (19, 21) sts,
work in pat to end.

Row 2 (WS): Work in double seed st to
m, sl m, work in diamonds to next m, sl
m, work next 9 (5, 9) sts in double seed st.
Place rem sts for Right Front on st holder.
Working only on these 41 (47, 51) sts, cont
in pat as established until piece measures
32" (81cm), ending with a WS row.

Buttonhole Row 1 (RS): Work in pat as
established until last 6 sts, k2tog, yo, ssk,
work last 2 sts in pat.

Buttonhole Row 2 (WS): Work 3 sts in
pat, (k1, p1) in yo, work to end in pat.
Cont to work in pat as established, rep
Buttonhole every 4" (10.2cm) twice more.
At the same time, when piece measures
38" (97cm), ending with a WS row,
remove m and beg working in double
seed st across Left Front.

When piece measures 44" (112cm),
ending with a WS row, BO all sts in pat.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg: begin/beginning

BO: bind off

cm: centimeter

CO: cast on

cont: continue

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

m: marker

p: purl

pat: pattern

pm: place marker

rem: remain/remaining

rep: repeat/repeats

RS: right side

sl: slip

ssk: slip, slip, knit these 2 stitches
together—1 stitch decreased

st/sts: stitch/stitches

WS: wrong side

yo: yarn over

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Right Front

Place sts from holder onto needles, ready to beg on a WS row.

Work as for Left Front, working Buttonhole Rows as follows:

Buttonhole Row 1 (RS): Work 2 sts in pat, k2tog, yo, ssk, work to end in pat.

Buttonhole Row 2 (WS): Work in pat to last 4 sts, (k1, p1) in yo, work in pat to end.

Finishing

Weave in ends.

Block to measurements on Schematic.

Sew 3 buttons on each side on the Back, to match buttonholes.



□ RS: K; WS: P


● RS: P; WS: K

PROJECT TIP

Blocking a Finished Project

Before blocking a finished project, measure the dimensions and write them down. Soak the piece in water or wash it according to the yarn care instructions. Lay it out flat on a few dry towels and gently arrange, pat, or stretch it into the shape/dimensions you want. The original measurements will help you determine how much larger or smaller it should be after blocking. Let it dry completely before use. If the yarn is stretchy and doesn't stay blocked, try placing another dry towel on top of it to weight it down until it is fully dry.
