Georgia Baby Blanket

Skill Level
Intermediate

Finished Size
31½" x 31½" (80cm x 80cm)

Materials

- Willow Yarns™ Daily Worsted (100% superwash wool; 100g/218yd)
 - 732247-0063 Georgia Peach (1 ball): A
 - 732247-0028 Ice (2 balls): B
 - 732247-0058 Aquamarine (1 ball): C
 - 732247-0032 Steel (1 ball): D
 - 732247-0017 Blue Sky (1 ball): E
- US size H-8 (5mm) hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle

Gauge
5 C2C squares x 5 C2C squares = 4" (10.2cm)
Save time, check your gauge.

Pattern Note

- Ch 3 does not count as a dc.

Stitch Guide

C2C inc:

Ch 6.

Row 1: Dc in the fourth ch from hook, dc in next 2 chs—1 square.

Next Row: Ch 6, turn, dc in fourth ch from hook, dc in next 2 chs, sl st in ch-3 sp, ch 3, 3 dc in ch-3 sp—2 squares.

Next Row: Ch 6, turn, dc in fourth ch from hook, dc in next 2 chs, *sl st in ch-3 sp, ch 3, 3 dc in ch-3 sp; rep from * to end of row—1 square inc'd.

C2C dec:

Next Row: Ch 1, turn, sl st in each of the next 3 dc, *sl st in ch-3 sp, 3 sc in ch-3 sp; rep from * to end of row, sl st in last ch-3 sp of row—1 square dec'd.

Instructions

Follow the C2C inc instructions, inc'ing 1 square per row until work reaches 39 squares, then follow the C2C dec instructions until there is only 1 square, using the following color sequence:

Rows 1-7: A

Rows 8-10: B

Rows 11-17: C

Rows 18-20: B

Rows 21-27: D

Rows 28-30: B

Rows 31-37: E

Rows 38-40: B

Rows 41-47: A

Rows 48-50: B

Rows 51-57: C

Rows 58-60: B

Rows 61-67: D

Rows 68-70: B

Rows 71-77: E

Fasten off.

Edging

Join B in any st and sc evenly along all 4 sides of blanket with 3 sc in the corners.

Rep using A, C, D, E, and again with B. Fasten off.

PROJECT TIP

Care Guide for Handmade Gifts

When you give a knit or crochet item as a gift, include a small tag, label, or note with care instructions that are specific to the yarn from which it was made. This will save the recipient from having to guess how to clean or care for the item and avoid potential damage due to incorrect laundering.

sc: single crochet

sl st: slip stitch
