Materials

3

- Willow Yarns™ Wash DK (100% anti-pill acrylic; 100g/273yd)
-732251-0024 Snow (3 balls): MC
-732251-0035 Sunshine (1 ball): A
-732251-0031 Orange Peel (1 ball): B
-732251-0001 Red Apple (1 ball): C
-732251-0003 Cooked Quince (1 ball): D
-732251-0017 Hyacinth (1 ball): E
- US size F-5 (3.75mm) hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle

Gauge

Rnds 1-7 = 4" (10.2cm) across
Finished Square = 6" (15.2cm) across
Save time, check your gauge.

Stitch Guide

cl (cluster): (Yo, insert hook in st and pull up a lp, yo and pull through 2 lps on hook) twice, yo and pull through all 3 lps on hook.

popcorn: Work 3 dc into next st, drop lp off hook and insert hook under the first dc, grab dropped lp and pull under first dc, ch 1 to close popcorn.

square:

With CC1, ch 4, sl st to form a ring.

Rnd 1: With CC1, ch 3 (counts as a dc here and throughout), 11 dc in ring, sl st in third ch of beg ch 3 to join—12 dc.

Rnd 2: Cut CC1 and join CC2, ch 2, yo, insert hook into same st as join and pull up a lp, (yo and pull through 2 lps on hook) twice (beg cl made), ch 1, (cl in next dc, ch 1) 11 times, sl st in top of beg cl to join—12 ch-1 sps, 12 cl.

Rnd 3: Cut CC2 and join CC3, ch 1, *sc in next cl, work a long dc into Rnd 1 bet last and next cl; rep from * around, sl st in first sc to join, fasten off—12 sc, 12 long dc.

Rnd 4: Join CC4 in any long dc, ch 1, sc in same st, work popcorn in next sc, *sc in next dc, work popcorn in next sc; rep from * around, sl st in first sc to join—12 sc, 12 popcorn.

Rnd 5: Cut CC4 and join CC5, ch 1, sc in same sc as join, ch 3, *sc in next sc, ch 3; rep from * around, sl st in first sc to join—12 ch-3 sps.

Rnd 6: With CC5, sl st in first ch-3 sp, (ch 3, 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same sp, 3 hdc in each of next 2 ch-3 sps, *(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp, 3 hdc in each of next 2 ch-3 sps; rep from * twice more, sl st in third ch of beg ch 3 to join, fasten off—4 ch-2 corner sps.

Rnd 7: Join MC in any corner sp, ch 3, (dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in same sp, dc in each of next 12 dc, *(2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp, dc in each of next 12 dc; rep from * twice more, sl st in third ch of beg ch 3 to join—4 ch-1 corner sps.

Rnd 8: Sl st to ch-1 sp, ch 3, (dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in same sp, dc in each of next 16 dc, *(2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch-1 sp, dc in each of next 16 dc; rep from * twice more, sl st in third ch of beg ch 3 to join, fasten off.

Instructions

Make 17 squares with A for CC1, B for CC2, C for CC3, D for CC4, and E for CC5.

Make 18 squares with E for CC1, D for CC2, C for CC3, B for CC4, and A for CC5.

Finishing

With MC, join squares tog from the WS with a sc (work through the outer lp of each st to leave the inner lps to show on the RS), using the assembly diagram as a guide.

With MC, work 1 rnd of sc around throw, working 3 sc in each corner, fasten off. Weave in ends and lightly block.

sk: skip

sl st: slip stitch

sp/sps: space/spaces

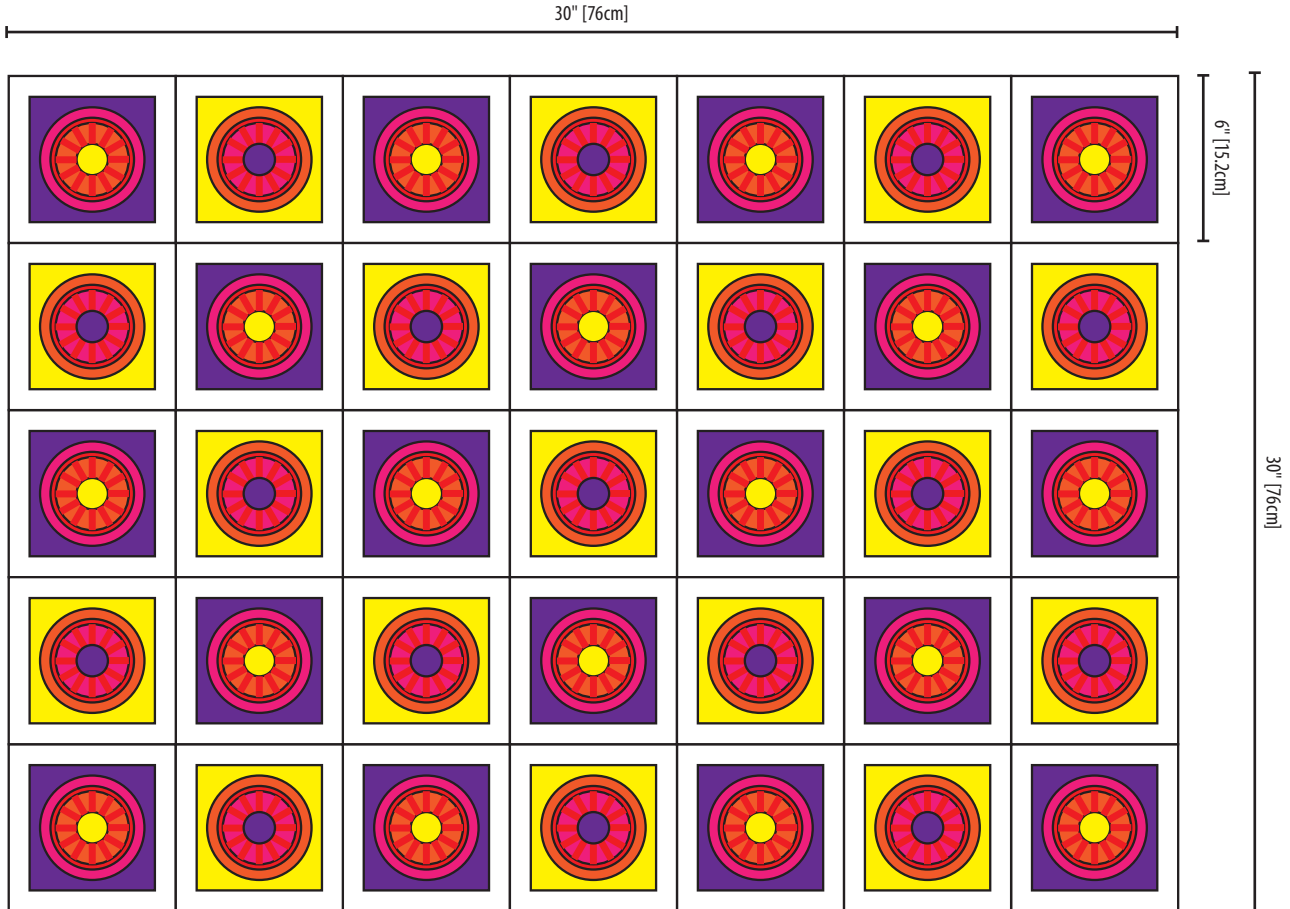

PROJECT TIP

Care Guide for Handmade Gifts

When you give a knit or crochet item as a gift, include a small tag, label, or note with care instructions that are specific to the yarn from which it was made. This will save the recipient from having to guess how to clean or care for the item and avoid potential damage due to incorrect laundering.
