2 (4, 6) yrs

Chest: 11½ (12½, 13½)"

[29 (32, 34)cm]

## Materials

- Willow Yarns™ Farmhouse Cotton (100% cotton; 100g/328yd)  
-730199-0030 Dusk (1 ball): A  
-730199-0025 Magnolia (1 ball): B  
-730199-0049 Dusty Rose 2 balls: C
- US size F-5 (3.75mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- US size G-6 (4mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle

## Gauge

18 sc x 24 rows = 4" (10.2cm)

24 sts x 9 rows = 4" (10.2cm) in wave st

*Save time, check your gauge.*

## Pattern Notes

- Bodice is worked first starting at bow. Skirt is worked from ribbon section down.
- Join is always with a sl st unless otherwise noted.
- Ch 2 counts as dc unless otherwise noted.
- The skirt length can be made to any length because of working from bodice down.

## Stitch Guide

**color change:** Work last st before color change. Leave last 2 lps on hook, drop working color, with new color, yo, pull through 2 lps on hook.

## Instructions

### Front

With size F-5 hook and A, ch 53 (57, 61).

**Row 1:** Working in bottom bumps of chs, sc in second ch from hook, sc in each ch to end. Turn—52 (56, 60) sc.

**Rows 2-9 (2-12, 2-12):** Ch 1, sc in each sc to end, change to B. Turn.

**Rows 10-18 (13-24, 13-24):** Ch 1, sc in each sc to end. Turn.

**Row 19 (25, 25):** Sl st first 2 (3, 4) sts, sc to last 2 (3, 4) 3 sc, leave last 2 (3, 4) sc unworked. Turn—48 (50, 52) sc.

**Row 20 (26, 26):** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc to last 2 sc, sc2tog. Turn—46 (48, 50) sc.

**Rows 21-22 (27-28, 27):** Rep Row 20 (26, 26). Turn—42 (44, 48) sc.

**Rows 23-38 (29-45, 28-51):** Ch 1, sc to end. Turn.

### Left Front Neck and Shoulder

**Row 39 (46, 52):** Ch 1, sc 12 (16, 17), sc2tog. Turn. Leaving rem sts unworked—13 (17, 18) sc.

**Row 40 (47, 53):** Ch 1 sc to end. Turn.

**Row 41 (48, 54):** Ch 1, sc 11 (15, 16), sc2tog. Turn—12 (16, 17) sc.

**Row 42 (49, 55):** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc to end. Turn—11 (15, 16) sc.

**Row 43 (50, 56):** Ch 1, sc 9 (13, 14), sc2tog. Turn—10 (14, 15) sc.

*Size 2 only:*

**Rows 44-46:** Ch 1, sc to end. Fasten off

*Size 4 only:*

**Row 51:** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc to end. Turn—13 sc.

**Row 52:** Ch 1, sc 11, sc2tog. Turn—12 sc.

**Row 53:** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc to end. Turn—11 sc.

**Row 54:** Ch 1, sc 9, sc2tog. Fasten off—10 sc.

*Size 6 only:*

**Row 57:** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc to end. Turn—14 sc.

**Row 58:** Ch 1, sc 12, sc2tog. Turn—13 sc.

**Row 59:** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc to end. Turn—12 sc.

**Row 60:** Ch 1, sc 10, sc2tog. Turn—11 sc.

**Row 61:** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc to end. Turn—10 sc.

**Row 62:** Ch 1, sc to end. Fasten off—10 sc.

### Right Front Neck and Shoulder

**Row 39 (46, 52):** Sk 15 (8, 9) sc; join in next sc, sc2tog over next 2 sc, sc 12 (15, 17). Turn—13 (17, 18) sc.

**Row 40 (47, 53):** Ch 1 sc to end. Turn.

**Row 41 (48, 54):** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc to end. Turn—12 (16, 17) sc.

**Row 42 (49, 55):** Ch 1, sc 10 (14, 15), sc2tog. Turn—11 (15, 16) sc.

**Row 43 (50, 56):** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc to end. Turn—10 (14, 15) sc.

*Size 2 only:*

**Row 44-46:** Ch 1, sc to end. Fasten off.

*Size 4 only:*

**Row 51:** Ch 1, sc 12, sc2tog. Turn—13 sc.

**Row 52:** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc to end. Turn—12 sc.

**Row 53:** Ch 1, sc 10, sc2tog. Turn—11 sc.

**Row 54:** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc to end. Fasten off—10 sc.

*Size 6 only:*

**Row 57:** Ch 1, sc 13, sc2tog. Turn—14 sc.

**Row 58:** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc to end. Turn—13 sc.

**Row 59:** Ch 1, sc 11, sc2tog. Turn—12 sc.

**Row 60:** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc to end. Turn—11 sc.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**ch/chs:** chain/chains

**cm:** centimeter

**dc:** double crochet

**dc2tog:** double crochet 2 together

**lp/lps:** loop/loops

**rem:** remain/remaining

**rep:** repeat

**RS:** Right Side

**sc:** single crochet

**sc2tog:** single crochet 2 together

**sk:** skip

**sl st:** slip stitch

**st/sts:** stitch/stitches

**yo:** yarn over

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**Row 61:** Ch 1, sc 9, sc2tog. Turn—10 sc.

**Row 62:** Ch 1, sc to end. Fasten off.

## Back

Rep same as Front through Row 38 (45, 51).

**Rows 39-43 (46-51, 52-59):** Ch 1, sc to end. Turn.

## Left Back Shoulder

**Row 44 (52, 60):** Ch 1, sc 11, sc2tog. Turn. Leave rem sts unworked—12 sc.

**Row 45 (53, 61):** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc to end. Turn—11 sc.

**Row 46 (54, 62):** Ch 1, sc 9, sc2tog. Fasten off—10 sc.

## Right Shoulder

**Row 44 (52, 60):** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc to end. Turn. Leave rem sts unworked—12 sc.

**Row 45 (53, 61):** Ch 1, sc 10, sc2tog. Turn—11 sc.

**Row 46 (54, 62):** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc to end. Fasten off—10 sc.

Seam shoulders and sides in matching yarn.

## Skirt

Turn bodice upside down, working skirt from ribbon (A) down.

**Row 1:** With RS facing and size G-6 hook, join C at seam. Ch 1, (sc 4, 2 sc in next st) 20 (22, 23) times, sc 4 (2, 5); join to first sc. Turn—124 (134, 143) sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, (sc 4, 2 sc in next sc) 21 (24, 24) times, sc 19 (13, 25); join to first sc. Turn—145 (157, 169) sc.

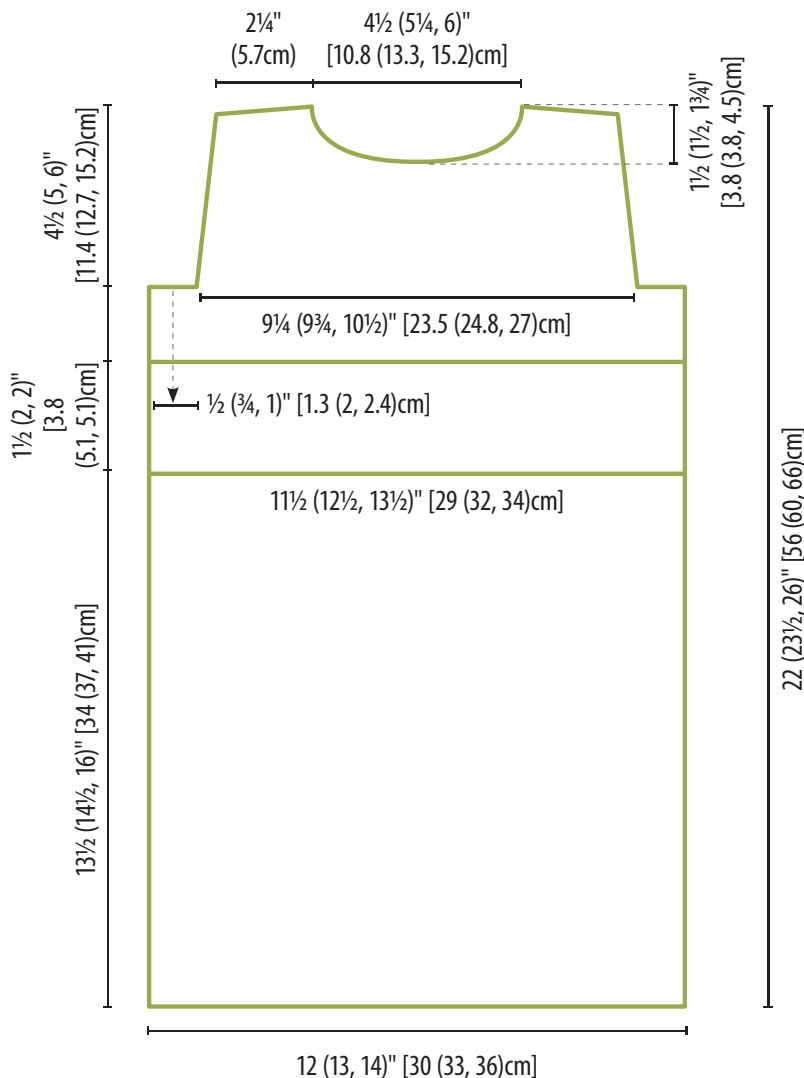
**Row 3 (RS):** Working in back lps only now and throughout. Ch 2, dc in first 4 sc, (dc2tog) twice, \*dc 3, 2 dc in next 2 sc, dc 3, (dc2tog) twice; rep from \* to last 5 sc. Dc 3, 2 dc in next sc, dc in last sc; join. Turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 2, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next 2 dc, dc 3, (dc2tog) twice, dc 3, \*2 dc in next 2 dc, dc 3, (dc2tog) twice, dc 3; rep from \* to first dc. Dc in base of first dc; join. Turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 2, dc in sl st, dc in next 3 dc, (dc2tog) twice, dc 3, \*2 dc in next 2 dc, dc 3, (dc2tog) twice, dc 3; rep from \* to last 2 dc. 2 dc in next dc, dc in last dc. Join. Turn.

**Rows 6-29 (6-31, 6-35):** Rep Rows 4-5.

**Row 30 (32, 36):** Rep Row 4.



## Edges

**Neck:** Attach B with a sl st at shoulder seam. Ch 1, sc evenly in each st and end of row around neck opening; join. Fasten off.

**Armhole:** Attach B with a sl st at underarm seam. Ch 1, sc in each st and end of row around; join. Fasten off. Rep for second armhole.

## Bow

**Row 1:** With A, ch 21, working in bottom bump of chs, sc in second ch from hook, sc in each ch to end. Turn—20 sc.

**Rows 2-9 (2-12, 2-12):** Ch 1, sc in each sc. Fasten off.

## Center Tie

**Row 1:** Ch 5, sc in second ch from hook, sc in each ch. Turn—4 sc.

**Rows 2-6 (2-8, 2-8):** Ch 1, sc in each sc. Do not fasten off.

## Finishing

Pinch center of bow, wrap tie around pinched center, sl st ends of tie tog. Fasten off, leaving a 10" (25cm) tail.

Using tail, sew tie to center of ribbon (A strip), sew tie across 3 sts. Fasten off. Straighten bow to your liking. Sew a stitch on each corner of bow.

Weave in all ends. Lightly block.
