Freyda Fingerless Mitts

Skill Level

Easy

Finished Size

3½" x 6½" (9cm x 16.5cm)

Materials

- Willow Yarns™ Glacier (50% wool/25% acrylic/25% nylon; 50g/98yd -730261-0004 Tidewater (1 ball))
- US size 6 (4mm) straight needles or size needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle

Gauge

22 sts x 28 rows = 4" (10.2cm)

in St st

Save time, check your gauge.



Instructions

CO 40 sts.

Row 1 (WS): *K3, p1; rep from * across.

Row 2 (RS): *K3, p1; rep from * across.

Rows 3-12: Rep Rows 1-2.

Row 13: P.

Row 14: K.

Rows 15-39: Rep Rows 13-14.

Rows 40-47: Rep Rows 1-2.

BO in pat.

Finishing

Block as needed.

With RS facing, fold panel in half with ends of rows touching. Sew 2" (5.1 cm) from the bottom (Row 1), leave 1¼" (3.2cm) opening for thumb, sew the remaining length of edge.

ABBREVIATIONS

cm: centimeter

CO: Cast On

k: knit

p: purl

rep: repeat

RS: Right Side

st/sts: stitch/stitches

St st: Stockinette stitch

WS: Wrong Side

PROJECT TIP

Organize Your Supplies

Knitting and crocheting is easier and more enjoyable when your supplies are accessible and organized. Try keeping a notebook of information on the yarn in your stash, including brand, color name or number, weight, care instructions, and amount that you have left. Update the list regularly so you always know what you have on hand. Also, keep your needles and hooks organized by size so they are easy to access for each project.
