Finished Size

Circumference: 11" (28cm)

Length: 4½" (11.4cm)

Materials

- Willow Yarns™ Drift 
(70% superwash wool/
30% rayon from bamboo;
100g/275yd)
-730267-0101 Granite (1 ball)
- US size 6 (4mm) straight
needles or size needed to
obtain gauge
- Yarn needle

Gauge

16 sts x 16 rows = 4" (10.2cm)

in St st

Save time, check your gauge.

Stitch Guide

sk2p: Sl 1 as if to k, k2tog, pass
slipped st over.

Pattern Notes

- Boot cuff is made in one
panel. Sew Row 1 to last row
to finish.

Instructions

CO 30.

Rows 1 (RS): K3, *k3, p3; rep from *
across to last 3 sts, k3.

Rows 2-4: K3, *k3, p3; rep from * across
to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 5: K3, *yo, sk2p, yo, k3; rep from *
across to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 6: K3, p to last 3 sts, k3.

Rows 7-10: K3, *p3, k3; rep from * across
to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 11: K3, *k3, yo, sk2p, yo; rep from *
across to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 12: K3, p to last 3 sts, k3.

Rows 13-83: Rep Rows 1-12 seven more
times, ending with Row 11.

BO in pat of Row 12.

Use yarn needle to sew ends tog.

Weave in ends.

Rep to make second boot cuff.

ABBREVIATIONS

BO: Bind Off

cm: centimeter

CO: Cast On

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 together

p: purl

pat: pattern

rep: repeat

RS: Right Side

sl: slip

st/sts: stitch/stitches

St st: Stockinette stitch

tog: together

yo: yarn over

PROJECT TIP

Organize Your Supplies

Knitting and crocheting is easier and more enjoyable when your supplies are accessible and organized. Try keeping a notebook of information on the yarn in your stash, including brand, color name or number, weight, care instructions, and amount that you have left. Update the list regularly so you always know what you have on hand. Also, keep your needles and hooks organized by size so they are easy to access for each project.
