

potluck casserole cozy



Potluck Casserole Cozy

Skill Level

Easy

Finished Size

To fit a 9" x 13½" (22.9cm x 34cm) pan

Materials

- Willow Yarns™ Lillia (60% cotton/40% polyester; 250g/136yd) -730110-0008 Ruby (2 balls)
- US size K-10½ (6.5mm) hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle

Gauge

10 sts x 11 rows = 4" (10.2cm)

Save time, check your gauge.

Stitch Guide

sc2tog (single crochet 2 together):

(Draw up a lp in the next st) twice, yo and draw through all 3 lps on hook.

hdc2tog (half double crochet 2 together):

(Yo, insert hook in next st, yo and pull up a lp) twice, yo and draw through all lps on hook.

Pattern Notes

- Pattern gauge is very tight. This helps create a sturdy carrier.

Instructions

Base

Ch 25.

Row 1: Sc in second ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 1, turn.

Row 2: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn.

Note: The following will now be worked in rnds.

Rnd 1: Sc in each st across to last st, (sc, ch 2, sc) in last st, working in end of Row 1, work 1 sc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in bottom lp from starting ch, sc in each bottom lp of starting ch across to

last bottom lp, (sc, ch 2, sc) in last bottom lp, working on opposite end of Row 1 work 1 sc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in first sc from Row 2, sl st to first sc made in this rnd—54 sc.

Rnds 2-5: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, working (sc, ch 2, sc) in each ch-2 sp, sl st to first sc to join—86 sc at end of Rnd 5. At end of Row 5, ch 1, turn.

Note: The following will now be worked in rows.

Row 1: Sc in each st across. Ch 1, turn—33 sc.

Rows 2-6: Rep Row 1. At end of Row 7, fasten off. Join yarn with sl st in ch-2 corner sp, on opposite side of base.

Row 1: Sc in first st and in each st across. Ch 1, turn—33 sc.

Rows 2-6: Rep Row 1. Do not fasten off at end of Row 6.

Note: The following will now go back to working in Rnds.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in each st across being sure to work (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in each corner stitch and working up sides evenly, sl st to first sc to join.

Sides

Rnd 2: Working in back lps only, sc in each st around, skipping ch-2 sps, sl st to first sc to join—114 sc.

Rnd 3-6: Working in both lps, sc in each st around, sl st to first sc to join. Fasten off at end of Rnd 6.

Handles

Working from corner down long side, sk first 3 sts.

Row 1: Join with sl st in next st, ch 1, sc in same st as sl st, hdc in next 11 sts, hdc2tog over next 2 sts, hdc in next 12 sts, sc in next st. Ch 1, turn—24 hdc, 2 sc.

Row 2: Sk first sc, hdc in front bump of each hdc from previous row, sk last sc. Ch 1, turn.

Row 3: Hdc in back bump of each hdc from previous row. Ch 1, turn.

Row 4: Hdc in front bump of each hdc from previous row. Ch 1, turn.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch: chain

cm: centimeter

dc: double crochet

hdc: half double crochet

lp/lps: loop/loops

rem: remain/remaining

rep: repeat

rnd/rnds: round/rounds

sc: single crochet

sk: skip

sl st: slip stitch

sp/sps: space/spaces

st/sts: stitch/stitches

Row 5: Working in back bump of hdc from previous row, hdc2tog, hdc across to last 2 sts, hdc2tog. Ch 1, turn.

Row 6: Working in front bump of hdc from previous row, hdc in each st across. Ch 1, turn.

Rows 7-16: Rep Rows 5-6 until 12 hdc rem.

Row 17: Sc2tog, sc in next 6 sts, sc2tog. Ch 1, turn—8 sc.

Row 18: Sc in first st, ch 8, sc in last st. Ch 1, turn.

Row 19: Sc in first st, 8 sc in ch-8 sp, sc in last st. Fasten off.

Rep handle on opposite side. Do not fasten off.

Edging

Sc evenly around edge of cozy, sl st to first sc. Fasten off. Weave in all ends.
